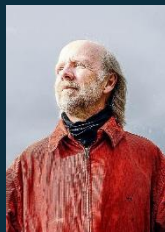

Up to two (2) submissions per presenter will be accepted, one as a poster and one as an oral presentation, and there will be no restrictions on the number of co-authored submissions.
